

Bocconi University – position of professore associato in Private Law at the Department of Legal Studies

The Department of Legal Studies invites applications from outstanding scholars for a position as associate professor with tenure (“professore associato”) in Private Law. Pursuant to Italian law, applicants are required to hold an “Abilitazione Scientifica Nazionale” (“ASN”) issued in a public competition for the scientific sector IUS01 (Diritto privato). Applicants must have an excellent publications record in the field of Private Law (including articles in top international journals). Preference will be given to candidates holding a Ph.D., SJD or equivalent degree, and/or an LLM (preferably from a leading international Institution). Substantive periods of research and/or teaching at leading international institutions will be given due consideration. Candidates must be perfectly fluent in Italian and English, and should have a strong command of either French or German.

Responsibilities will include conducting research at the national and international level leading to publications in important national and international outlets, and teaching undergraduate, graduate and post-graduate courses in both Italian and English. Service to the Institution is also required. Compensation, benefits, research funds, facilities, and teaching loads are competitive with leading European institutions.
