

Bocconi University – position of Assistant Professor in Comparative Law at the Department of Legal Studies

The Department of Legal Studies invites applications from outstanding scholars for an Assistant Professor position in Private Comparative Law.

Applicants should have an adequate track-record of publications in the field of Comparative Law, a Ph.D. and/or a LL.M., and demonstrate a strong potential in research.

Applicants must demonstrate a strong aptitude for teaching and research in all areas of private comparative law. Candidates must also demonstrate aptitude for carrying out research and teaching activities at a supranational level, for example by showing proof of studies and research periods abroad, or by holding courses taught in English or by participating in international research projects.

It is also expected that the postholder will reach high standards in teaching and contribute to various aspects of the academic life of the Faculty.

The working languages at Bocconi University are Italian and English. Salaries, research funds and teaching loads are competitive with leading academic European institutions.
